## FIRE PREVENTION RULES FOR STUDENTS LIVING IN THE UNIVERSITY HOSTEL

## Students living in hostels are required to:

- 1. Comply with all the instructions of the hostel administration on fire safety;
- 2. Switch off electrical appliances, turn off the lights, close doors and windows when leaving the room;
- 3. Use gas stoves, electrical and heating appliances very carefully;

## It is strictly prohibited:

- 1. To overload the electrical circuit, i.e. plug in one socket (with or without power strips) electrical appliances which total power is more than 1100 W;
- 2. To use in rooms electrical appliances such as heaters, boilers, irons, cookers, microwave ovens, etc. Ironing is allowed only in a special room;
- 3. To use gas cookers and electrical appliances for other purposes that brakes fire prevention rules;
- 4. To smoke cigarettes, hookahs, e-cigarettes as well as their analogues and modifications on the territory and inside the buildings of Lobachevsky University.

## In case of fire:

- 1. Keep calm. Leave the room and close the door but do not lock it;
- 2. Call the Fire Fighting Service by phone **«101»** or **«112»** and inform the hostel administration about the fire. Then follow the instructions of the hostel administration;
- 3. If the corridors and stairwells are smoky and you cannot safely exit the area, stay in your room. All the holes including vents through which smoke can enter the room must be plugged with a wet towel or other material moistened with water. Then go to the window and give signals to firefighters (wave hands or use flashlights in your phone).
- 4. Do not enter a room that contains a high concentration of smoke. You will not be able to get through the smoky area without special respiratory protection. If the room is filled with smoke, go to the side of the non-smoky staircase, or to the exit;
- 5. Wait for the fire brigade.
