Universitas Islam Indonesia
2 – 5 August 2022

Background

Indonesia has been known for its unity in diversity. This unique legacy is being nurtured by its society, having a lot of diversity of culture, beliefs, traditions, languages, arts, and typical buildings. The rich of culture of Indonesia inspired Universitas Islam Indonesia (UII) to develop a short program with the topic “Indonesian Heritage Story (IHS)” that will provide opportunities for the participants to learn and experience in-class and outdoor activities regarding the topic.

The IHS 2022 will target international students to study in Indonesia at a certain time, especially the ones who visit Indonesia for the very first time. We expect that the IHS 2022 will be their “First Door” in visiting Indonesia so that they will have a brief experience and overview of Indonesia.

In line with the theme “Preserving Our Heritage,” we try to make them realize that our history is a vital part of our civilization. Therefore, this program is designed to invite the participants to look at their neighborhoods and preserve the cultural heritage that we have in our home country.

Objectives

The objectives of this program are to:

1. Implement international collaboration between UII and partner universities in overseas;
2. Introduce Indonesia and Universitas Islam Indonesia;
3. Promote the multicultural awareness and cross-cultural understanding among the students;
4. Capture innovative ideas regarding the program’s topic;
5. Develop international networking among participants; and
6. Create an internationalization at home for UII students joining this program.

Target Participants

The target participants of this program are:

1. UII students as student buddies
2. UII partner universities’ students, with the general requirements:
 - active student with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00/4.00
 - good command of English (equal to B1 level)
 - good health

All the participants have to register at a link that will be provided by UII. The link will require you to upload the documents that we need and answer several questions related to your eligibility for the program. All the activities will be reported to the ministry of education, culture, research and technology of the Republic of Indonesia.

After completing the program, participants will get a **certificate**.

- Subsidy of flight tickets with a maximum of IDR 2,000,000/person (at cost, by submitting the receipt of flight ticket payment after arrival to UII);
- Accommodation during the program from 1 August – 6 August 2022 (the hotel check-out date will be on 6 August 2022 at 12 PM). UII will not cover the additional stay in Yogyakarta;
- Program fee, including meals during the program; and
- Program kits.
